Teacher Assessment Framework

- List of statements which children need to demonstrate they can achieve
 - Working towards, Expected, Greater Depth
 - Pre-Key Stage for children working below
 - Statements for reading, writing and maths
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Reading

Two reading papers
for children to
complete

Assesses a range of
reading skills

Retrieval, Inference,
Sequencing,
Vocabulary

No specific time limit

Used alongside
classroom
assessments to make
judgements



Maths

Two maths papers for children to complete

Arithmetic and Reasoning

Assesses a range of reading skills

Place value, Calculations, Shape, Measure, Fractions, Data Handling

No specific time limit

Used alongside classroom assessments to make judgements

Writing

Two papers for children to complete

Spelling and Grammar

Assesses a range of skills

Spelling, Punctuation, Vocabulary, Standard English

No specific time limit

No standardised writing assessment (writing in class is assessed)

Used alongside classroom assessments to make judgements

Final Teacher Assessments

- Raw Score -> Scaled Score Conversion
 - Working towards < 100
 - Working at expected level = 100 – 109
 - Working at greater depth > 109
- Evidence gathered from all class assessments
- Assessments made against the Teacher Assessment Frameworks
- Final assessments will be reported in their end of year reports
